### TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL:

God uses strategic relationships to accomplish his mission in the Earth. We see this play in the text. Phillip has an encounter with Jesus and recognizes him as the Messiah. Phillip then finds Nathaniel to tell him about Jesus. Nathaniel was skeptical, but eventually came around to believe and follow Jesus.

God has placed skeptics and non-believers strategically in our lives. They are in our neighborhoods, on our jobs, serving us in restaurants and even in our churches! God desires for us to use those relationships as a bridge to introduce them to Jesus.

We want to encourage everyone to write down their "Top 5." These are people who are non-Christians in your circle that you have some type of relational connection to and that God places on your heart. After identifying them, we want to pray that they would be open to a relationship with Jesus. As we are praying, we encourage you to love and serve them well. Share your testimony of Jesus' work in your life, as opportunity allows.
